Notice of Tax Revenue Increase

The Leon County Commissioner's Court conducted public hearings on Monday, August 22, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. and Monday, August 29, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Leon County from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by <u>-8.8%</u>.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of <u>.417777</u> for each \$100 of taxable value was <u>\$8,219,706</u>.

The total revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of <u>.417777</u> for each \$100 taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is <u>\$7,411,014</u>.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of $_.417777$ for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is $_$7,462,301$.
