The filing fees for Small Claims, Debt Claims, Repair and Remedy, & Eviction Petition are \$46.00 payable with a cashier's check or money order plus the service fee. Leon County civil service fee is an additional \$100.00 on each individual being served. Other Counties charge different fees and it is up to you prior to filing a Petition to find the County, precinct, and amount of service fee payable to the service entity if the Defendant is to be served in another County.
