The Citizen Corps program educates people in case of a natural or manmade disaster, and in how you can prepare to save lives in an emergency like the Sutherland Springs, Tx Church Shooting.

While emergency services personnel are the best trained and equipped to handle emergencies, they may not be immediately available in a catastrophic disaster. In such a situation, members of the community may be on their own for several days or longer. They may have to rely on their own resources for food, water, first aid, and shelter, and neighbors or coworkers may have to provide immediate assistance to those who are hurt or need other help. This is where Emergency/Disaster preparedness training will help you be prepared to help yourself and your family.

Trauma is the leading cause of death in Americans for those under age 46. Life-threatening emergencies can happen fast and emergency responders are not always nearby. One example would be the Sutherland Springs, Tx Church Shooting or the Las Vegas shooting. You may be able to save a life by taking simple actions immediately. Literally, "You Are the Help Until Help Arrives".
