**Instructions for Filling out a
Public Information Request Form**

1. Media Selection: CD-ROM, Paper, or Electronic
2. Optional Extracts: An option may be selected to select a limited group of voters. Suspense voters are those voters whose certificate was returned as non-deliverable from the Post Office.
3. The attached affidavit must be signed before a deputy election official OR a notary public. CD-ROM or the Electronic version will not be released until full payment is received. A complete address must be provided along with a telephone number. The Leon County Election Official will furnish information no later than the 15th day after the date the request is received. (Texas Election Code, Section 18.066)

§ 18.067 Unlawful Use of Master File Information

(a) A person commits an offense if the person uses information in connection with advertising or promoting commercial products or a service that the person knows was obtained under Section 18.066.

(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

Per state law, Early Voting Lists are public information and we are required to make each day's list available upon request the next day.
Texas Election Code Section 87.121 (g) "Information on the roster for a person who votes an early voting ballot by personal appearance shall be made available for public inspection not later than the beginning of regular business hours on the day after the date the information is entered on the roster..."
Per state law, voting history is public information and we are required to provide it upon request.
