To Whom It May Concern:

Leon County is a rural county therefore we do not require commercial or residential building permits and we are not a zoned area. We do require anyone that plans to build a building, a home or have a manufactured home delivered to contact our County Inspector for information on septic systems. You may contact Robbie Robinson at 903-322-3101.

On Wednesday, November 20, 2013, new flood maps for Leon County, Texas became effective. Because Leon County participates in the National Flood Insurance Program, all development and construction activities that occur within the floodplain require a floodplain development permit. Development and construction activities that occur outside of the floodplain do not require a floodplain development permit. The landowner should contact the County Judge office at 903-536-2331 (or the county website at www.co.leon.tx.us) to receive information on floodplain determination/ permitting procedures, and to obtain an application.
