DISASTER DECLARATION IN PREPARATION OF STORM RELATED MEASURES FOR HURRICANE MARCO AND LAURA

WHEREAS, the Governor of The State of Texas has issued a disaster proclamation that Hurricane Marco and, then, Tropical Storm Laura posed a threat of imminent disaster on August 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of The State of Texas has issued a proclamation declaring a disaster for Hurricane Marco and, now, Hurricane Laura adding Leon County to the Disaster Declaration pursuant to government code (418.014); and

WHEREAS, a Federal Declaration has been issued for the state of Texas authorizing Public Assistance Category B (Emergency Protective Measures); and

WHEREAS, Leon County declaring a disaster will facilitate and expedite the and deployment of resources to enhance preparedness and response; and


WHEREAS, Leon County has received request for livestock/animal sheltering, and:

WHEREAS, Leon County has dedicated livestock/animal storage sheltering for animals and owners with RV's.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF LEON COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. Leon County EXPO be opened to intake hurricane evacuated animals for sheltering during the Hurricane Marco and Hurricane Laura disaster declaration period.
2. Leon County will charge the daily cost rate per head, per animal, according to Leon County animal shelter boarding details passed by Commissioners Court as attached
